

Sycamore (*Platanus occidentalis*)



- Height:** Large, 75'-100'; up to 150' tall
Width: 75'-100' spread
Shape: Rounded with irregular crown
Growth: Fast growth rate
Light: Full sun, partial-sun, or shade
Leaves: Large maple-shaped leaves turn yellow and brown in fall
Flowers: Insignificant
Fruit: Globular achenes support wildlife
Soil: Alkaline, moist, loamy, well-drained soil
Water: High use
Drought: High tolerance once established
Flood: High tolerance once established
Disease: High risk
